ANNUAL REPORT 2005-06 SMALL INDUSTRIES SERVICE INSTITUTE HYDERABAD

About MSME – DI, Hyderabad:

MSME- Development Institute, Hyderabad was established in the year 1956, as a field Institute of the Small Industries Development Organization,(SIDO), with an objective to provide much needed consultancy and support to the small scale industrial sector. In Andhra Pradesh, MSME-DI, Hyderabad was the pioneer industrial consultancy organization. Even today, the Institute is dedicated to provide need based support to small scale entrepreneurs by providing various essential inputs like technical counseling regarding selection of product location, raw materials, machinery, layout, and product process, managerial consultancy, etc. The Institute also helps MSEs by imparting knowledge on new practices like modernization, technology upgradation, acquiring international quality systems, energy conservation, pollution control etc.

The training programmes organized by MSME-DI, Hyderabad are rated as one of the best in the State, as they encompass all aspects of starting and managing a small scale unit. The Entrepreneurship cum Skill Development Programmes, Entrepreneurship Development Programmes, Management Development Programmes, and the Skill Development Programmes focus on developing and sharpening the entrepreneurial, managerial and technical skills of the existing or prospective entrepreneur.

MSME - DI, Hyderabad is ably supported by its Branch Institute located at Visakhapatnam. The branch Institute's jurisdiction is over the four districts of North Coastal Andhra, namely, Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, and East Godavari.

The **MSME Testing Station**, **(MSME - TS)**, located strategically in Sanathnagar Industrial Estate, Hyderabad, functions under the administrative control of MSME –DI Hyderabad. It provides testing facilities for MSEs in the areas of physical testing, chemical analysis, etc. It provides consultancy services to MSEs on quality control and standardization procedures and systems testing to national and international standards, and provides 3rd party assurance for products and services from MSME sector on quality levels to major buyers like Government Departments, DGS&D, Railways, PSUs, Defence establishments,

etc. The testing center has been upgraded with the addition of sophisticated testing equipment.

DEMONSTRATION PROGRAMMES:

MSME-DI, Hyderabad organized product process demonstration programmes to demonstrate the process of manufacture of simple chemical products such as detergent powder, cold cream, talcum powder, candles, phenyl, etc. **190** persons were trained during 2005-06.

V. SEMINARS/WORKSHOPS ORGANIZED BY MSME-DI AND ITS BRANCH:

To create awareness on various issues of concern to the MSME sector, MSME-DI constantly organizes seminars and workshops, by partnering with Institutions of repute and Industry organizations. During the year 2005-06, MSME-DI and Br.MSME-DI organized the following Seminars and Workshops:

- Workshop on Coating tools: MSME-DI, Hyderabad, in association with Fiber Glass Industries Association of AP organized a one day Workshop on coating tools for Fibre Reinforced Plastics industry, at Hyderabad, on 23rd April 2005. 30 entrepreneurs participated in the programme
- MSME-DI, Hyderabad, associated with Confederation of Indian Industry,
 Hyderabad chapter, to organize a seminar on 'Public Private
 Partnership-Intellectual Property Rights-Protection for SMEs' on
 26th April 2005
- Seminar on Bio diesel: MSME-DI, Hyderabad, in association with the CommiMSMEonerate of Industries, Government of AP jointly organized a one day Seminar on Jatropha Cultivation and Bio- Diesel ProceMSMEng on 21.9.05. The Seminar was chaired by Shri VM

Manohar Prasad, IAS, Secretary, Department of Rain Shadow Area Development; Govt of AP. Director MSME-DI presided over the Seminar. Keynote address was delivered by Shri Engbert Grundemann, Director, Land use Innovations, Nandan Bio-Matrix, Hyderabad. Technical seMSMEons on - bio fuels as renewable energy sources, scope of Jatropha and Pongamia cultivation in dry land. management of Jatropha cultivation. Jatropha seed proceMSMEng, trans-esterification proceMSMEng of bio-diesel, by products, feasibility and economic viability in MSME sector etc followed. The Seminar was attended by 140 participants, including farmers, entrepreneurs, and officials from various Government Departments. Technical seMSMEons were handled by eminent scientists from Research Organizations, consultants and Machinery suppliers.

- MSME-DI, Hyderabad and Quality Development Society, jointly organized a one day Seminar on Intellectual Property Rights on 29th November 2005, at the Institute of Telecommunication Engineers Auditorium, for the benefit of Electronic and electrical units' cluster in and around Hyderabad. The seminar was inaugurated by Principal Director, NISIET. Technical seMSMEons were handled by Director, MSME-DI, CII, representative of Qaiser Iprex, APTechnology Development Cell. The topics dealt were- Geographical Indication, commercialization of Technology & IPR, Business impact of Innovation and IPR, etc. 150 persons from MSEs, Govt Organizations and others participated
- MSME-DI organized a Sensitization programme on Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme for Technology Upgradation, on 17.2.06, at the Institute's premises. GM, SIDBI, AGM, NABARD, representatives from Commercial Banks, and APSFC, and officers from MSME-DI made presentations on the features of the scheme. Panel discuMSMEons were held with entrepreneurs about the scheme. 85 MSME entrepreneurs participated
- A one day Sensitization programme on Bio technology was organized by MSME-DI, in association with FAPCCI, Hyderabad at Visakhapatnam

- on 4.3.06. 84 persons from various MSEs participated in the programme.
- MSME-DI, in association with Andhra University and National Productivity
 Council organized a Workshop on "Strategies for Enhancing Industrial Productivity" at Visakhapatnam on 23.3.06
- In association with NPC, MSME-DI organized a similar programme on Productivity enhancement in SMEs at Hyderabad on 29.3.06. 60 entrepreneurs and others attended the programme

VI. VENDOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

Promoting vendors by creating a platform for introducing large scale units and their requirements to small scale suppliers has been an important role being played by MSME-DI over the years. The Public Sector Units and Large industries require a variety of components, spares and services from the small scale sector regularly. To open such opportunities to the small scale sector, MSME-DI, Hyderabad organized three Vendor Development programmes during the year 2005-06:

National Level VDP: MSME-DI, Hyderabad organized a National Vendor Development Programme, Seminar-cum Exhibition on 14th and 15th December 2005, at ClaMSMEc Gardens, Secunderabad, in association with NSIC, CommiMSMEonerate of Industries, Govt of AP, and Federation of AP Small Industries Association. Shri H P Kumar, Chairman & Managing Director, NSIC Ltd was the chief guest, while Shri GS Bhowmick, GM, Visakhapatnam Steel Plant, was the Guest of Honour at the Seminar. Other dignitaries included Zonal General Manager, NSIC, Addl.Director, CommiMSMEonerate of Industries, GM(MM), VSP, and Past president, FAPSIA.

Around 250 stalls were set up at the venue, by small scale industries from AP, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Delhi, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Puna and Goa. PSUs like South Central Railway, Bharat Dynamics Ltd, HAL, NTPC, NFC, etc also displayed their products. Business enquires worth Rs. 6 crores were generated. 113 units were registered with VSP as Vendors

MSME-DI organized a meeting to follow up progress of NVDP organized during the last year, with Visakhapatnam Steel Plant. The meeting was held in the chambers of Executive Director, VSP, and was attended by senior officers from Ancillary Development Cell, Materials Management division etc of VSP, apart from 15 MSME Associations of Visakhapatnam region. At present, VSP sources its requirements from 146 local MSME units(located within a radius of 100km) and 395 non local MSEs, valued at Rs. 114 crores. VSP has assured participation in all future VDPs organized by MSME-DI.

State level VDP: Small Industries Service Institute Hyderabad organized a two day **National Seminar –Vendor Development Programme 'Focus SME – Unleashing the Power** ..' jointly with the Federation of AP Chambers of Commerce and Industry FAPCCI, and the Indian School of Business, Hyderabad (ISB) on 20th and 21st May 2005. The Major sponsors were the Government of AP, SIDBI, SBH and APSFC.

The Chief Guest at the Seminar was Shri G Vinod, Hon'ble Minister for Labour and Employment, Government of AP. Guest of Honor was Smt. Lakshmi Parthasarathy, IAS, Principal Secretary to Govt, Industries and Commerce Department. Other Dignitaries who shared the dais were Shri M. Ram Mohan Rao, Dean, ISB, Shri ARK Rao, Director, MSME-DI, Hyderabad, Shri Shekhar Agarwal, Chairman, SMEDC, FAPCCI, and Shri O.P. Goenka, President, FAPCCI. An exhibition of products of MSEs was arranged, showcasing the capabilities of the MSME sector. Business enquiries worth Rs. 1 crore were generated.

The Seminar focused on the growth of SME sector in the emerging scenario, and positioning of the sector for expanding markets. Director MSME-DI gave a special address on Vendor Development and chaired a technical seMSMEon on Marketing strategies.

MSME-DI, Hyderabad started an innovative training programme for Management Representatives of ISO 9001:2000. The programme is aimed at equipping candidates with Engineering/technical background for aMSEsting MSEs to

implement ISO 9001:2000 standards in ISO certified small scale units. 18 persons were trained

VII. Paper presentations:

- Director Shri ARK Rao made a presentation on 'Self Employment Opportunities – Role of MSME-DI' at a Workshop on Employment Opportunities for Tribals in various sectors, organized by ITDA Bhadrachalam
- Director made a presentation on 'Prospects of SMEs in the liberalized economy' at a seminar organized by APSFC at their Golden Jubilee celebrations
- Director and AD(EI) made a presentation on <u>"Training needs for MSME sector in the changed era"</u> at National Seminar on "Sustainable Development of SMEs: New Policy Initiatives" organized by NISIET during 23& 24 March 2006.
- Officers of various trades (Technical, EI & IMT) of MSME-DI & Br. MSME-DI
 regularly deliver talks on various topics of concern to New and existing
 entrepreneurs, at EDPs and other programmes organized by MSME
 development agencies like DICs, APSFC, Engineering Colleges,
 NISIET, etc.

VIII. Cluster Development Programme:

- With aMSEstance of CDE, the fan cluster of Balanagar, Hyderabad has been registered under Societies Act.
- Two units of the cluster were motivate to exhibit their products at International Trade fairs at Kenya, Johannesburg and Italy.
- The fan cluster organized a Divali Mela at Hyderabad in November 2005, to raise funds for the Fan Association. Rs. 6 lakhs were raised during the Mela.
- A business delegation of Members of Fan cluster and CDE, Shri Arvind Patwari, DD(Mech) of MSME-DI, Hyderabad visited Dubai and Colombo in December 2005 to organize Buyers-Sellers Meets. Business enquiries worth Rs2.5 crores were generated.

- Development Service Provider from Senior Export Service, Germany invited for aMSEsting the fan cluster, developed a four winged fan with good air delivery. The fan was designed, and a prototype was prepared by the CDE and the expert at facilities available with FTS, Hyderabad. After relevant tests were carried out, it was found that the new design had a better sweep, and showed a significant 20% increase in air delivery. A significant 40% reduction in net weight of the fan, and cost reduction of 30% has been achieved. A report on this is being submitted to the Head Quarters separately.
 - Five members of the cluster attended a B2B programme organized at Chennai on 6.1.06. They interacted with delegates from trade desk of Australian, Malaysian Embassy of Orbit travels, Dun & Bradstreet and EEPC.
 - Two units of the cluster are being financed by Indusind Bank and SIDBI towards Term Loan and Working capital.
- **IX. Production Returns**: MSME-DI, Hyderabad, with the help of Br. MSME-DI constantly send data on production of selected small scale units, to the Headquarters, for compilation of the production index. During the year, as per the target set, the Institute collected and sent 192 units production returns of 16 selected units manufacturing 18 important reserved items. Four hundred and thirty two (432 production returns of 108 units were sent on a quarterly basis).

X. PARTICIPATION IN EXHIBITIONS:

MSME-DI, Hyderabad participates in Exhibitions and fairs organized by other Agencies, to promote the message of Self employment through enterprise. During the year 2005-06, set up stalls at the National Science Congress, organized at NG Ranga Agricultural University, and inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. MSME-DI also set up a stall at Seminar/VDP 'Focus SME – unleashing the power" organized

at FAPCCI. Both the stalls were visited by many dignitaries and existing and prospective entrepreneurs.

XI. CO-ORDINATION WITH OTHER AGENCIES:

- 1. **Director, MSME-DI as a Committee Member:** Director, MSME-DI, Hyderabad is a member of various Committees in the State, set up by different Organizations, for implementing various policies of the Government of India, and Govt of AP. The important among them are the State Level Inter Institutional Committee for revival of sick units, (SLIIC), State Level Bankers Committee Meeting (SLBC), State Level Committee for implementation of PMRY, Task Force Committees in districts for PMRY candidates selection, State Level Guidance Committee of NABARD, DRIIP implementation Committee, RSQC committee of O/o DGFT, Selection Committees of NSIC, State Level committee meeting of C DAC. etc.
- 2. During the year, MSME-DI, Hyderabad has worked in close association with many MSME Development organizations in organizing programmes for the development of MSEs. Important among these are NISIET, CITD, SIDBI, NABARD, APSFC, APPC, CommiMSMEonerate of Industries & District Industries Centres, KVIC, ITDA, DRDA, etc.
- 3. MSME-DI also worked in close co-ordination with many Industry Associations and NGOs in promoting the interests of the MSME Sector. The Institute conducted many programmes in association with the Industry Associations, and also provided inputs like training, consultancy, and organization skills for jointly organizing programmes with them. Exclusive programme on self employment: ETV 2 channel made recordings of interviews with officers of the Institute for featuring in an exclusive programme on ETV 2, titled Yuvashakthi, which will be telecast national wide in different ETV channels. Shots of training programmes and other facilities/services offered by the Institute were filmed. The programme is scheduled to go on air on all national channels of ETV in April 2006.

The activities of MSME-DI, and the role played by MSME-DI in propagating the message of self employment was given ample coverage in various channels.

Apart from the above, many other press releases, advertisements, and news coverage on MSME-DI's and Br.MSME-DI's activities appeared in Newspapers and industry journals during the year under report.

 Visits of Dignitaries: AS&DC(MSME), Shri Satyananda Mishra, IAS, visited MSME-DI, Hyderabad on 24.6.05. Director, MSME-DI, Shri ARK Rao, briefed him about the activities of MSME-DI, Hyderabad. DC(MSME) presided over the Valedictory function of MDP on Jute products and awarded certificates to trainees. Later, DC(MSME) chaired a meeting of prominent representatives of Small Industry Associations of AP, and held discuMSMEons regarding status of MSEs in AP.
