**About MSME – DI, Hyderabad:**

MSME- Development Institute, Hyderabad was established in the year 1956, as a field Institute of the Small Industries Development Organization (SIDO), with an objective to provide much needed consultancy and support to the small scale industrial sector. In Andhra Pradesh, MSME-DI, Hyderabad was the pioneer industrial consultancy organization. Even today, the Institute is dedicated to provide need based support to Micro and small scale entrepreneurs by providing various essential inputs like technical counseling regarding selection of product location, raw materials, machinery, layout, and product process, managerial consultancy, etc. The Institute also helps Micro & Small scale Enterprises (MSEs) by imparting knowledge on new practices like modernization, technology upgradation, acquiring international quality systems, energy conservation, pollution control etc. MSME-DI implements the Ministry of MSME, GoI schemes in the state of Andhra Pradesh by spreading awareness about the schemes and identifying suitable beneficiaries.

The training programmes organized by MSME-DI, Hyderabad are rated as one of the best in the State, as they encompass all aspects of starting and managing a small scale unit. The Entrepreneurship cum Skill Development Programmes (ESDP), Entrepreneurship Development Programmes(EDP), Management Development Programmes(MDP), and the Skill Development Programmes (SDP) focus on developing and sharpening the entrepreneurial, managerial and technical skills of the existing or prospective entrepreneur.

MSME - DI, Hyderabad is ably supported by its **Branch Institute located at Visakhapatnam**. The branch Institute's jurisdiction is over the five districts of North Coastal Andhra, namely, Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari and West Godavari .

The **MSME Testing Station, (MSME - TS)**, located strategically in Sanathnagar Industrial Estate, Hyderabad, functions under the administrative control of MSME –DI Hyderabad. It provides testing facilities for MSEs in the areas of physical testing,

chemical analysis, etc. It provides consultancy services to MSEs on quality control and standardization procedures and systems testing to national and international standards, and provides third party assurance for products and services from MSME sector on quality levels to major buyers like Government Departments, DGS&D, Railways, PSUs, Defence establishments, etc. The testing center has been upgraded with the addition of sophisticated testing equipment.

1) Government of AP constituted a State Level Steering Committee of MSE-CDP vide G.O.Ms.No.249 dated 8-12-2009 amended vide G.O.Ms.No.55 dated 15-6-2010 under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary MSME & Food Processing, Govt. of A.P.; with Director MSME-DI Hyderabad as its Member Convenor and with 8 other Members comprising of APSFC, Andhra Bank, SIDBI, NABARD, KVIB, KVIC, Commissioner of Industries, Govt. of A.P. to coordinate and monitor the progress of implementation of MSE- CDP in A.P.

The First Meeting of the State Level Steering Committee was held on 16-9-2010 at MSME-DI Hyderabad under the Chairmanship of Shri J.C.Sharma, Principal Secretary, MSME & Food Processing, Govt. of A.P. Progress of MSE-CDP was reviewed and further suggestions were given by the Steering Committee Meeting for effective implementation of MSE-CDP in A.P.

2) MSME-DI is constantly interacting with cluster enterprises, Associations and their representatives for enabling them to take advantage of MSE-CDP.

MSME-DI has motivated and guided the following clusters for submission of applications for in principle approval to DC (MSME). Based on the proposals forwarded by MSME DI, in principle approval was accorded for three of these clusters in the meetings of Steering Committee of MSE- CDP held on 2-6-2010

and 23-8-2010. The detailed status of the clusters for which applications were forwarded by MSME DI is given below:

**a) Fan cluster Hyderabad & b) Pharma Cluster, Uppal – Cherlapally**

**(Hyderabad) :**

In principle approvals for establishing common facility centers having a project cost of 15 crores in each of the two clusters have been accorded by the Steering Committee. As advised by O/o DC( MSME) quotations have been called for identifying a suitable agency for preparing DPRs for the CFCs. Agency identified & the proposal has been forwarded for Hqtrs. Approval. Further, O/o DC(MSME) has also been requested for extending time period till June 2011 for preparation of DPR. Approval for the same is awaited.

**c) Stone Cutting & Polishing cluster Tandur :** In-principle approval was accorded for establishing a common facility centre having a project cost of Rs.12 crores. O/o DC (MSME) advised Commissioner of Industries Govt. of A.P. for identifying suitable agency for preparation of DPR. MSME DI is pursuing the matter with Commissioner of Industries, Govt. of AP and the cluster representatives.

**d)Agro Seeds Cluster, Ranga Reddy District & e) Electronics Cluster, Kushaiguda, Hyderabad :** Applications for in-principle approval for setting up of common facility centers at a project cost of Rs.15 crores in each cluster were submitted to DC (MSME). DC (MSME) advised for getting Diagnostic Study Reports (DSR) prepared for consideration of the CFC proposal. The cluster representatives got the DSR prepared and the same has been submitted to Hqtrs. Office after validation in a validation workshop organized at MSME-DI, Hyderabad As advised by O/o DC(MSME) an SPV has been formed and a DPR is being prepared by the association.

**f) Gold Ornaments cluster, Vijayawada :** Based on application submitted for in principle approval for setting up a CFC at a project cost of Rs.1.7 crores, O/o DC (MSME) advised for getting a DSR of the cluster prepared. However, in view of the smaller size of the CFC, and the observations made by the Director and other officers of MSME-DI during their visit to the cluster, the O/o DC



(MSME) has been requested for permitting preparation of DSR along with DPR for the cluster and thus giving in principle approval for the proposed CFC. Acceptance of our request from DC (MSME) has not come yet and in the meanwhile the cluster representatives have been supported for preparation of a DSR from their side.

3) MSME-DI submitted eight Infrastructure development proposals of LIDCAP, to DC MSME. Seven of the proposals for development of infrastructure in the following districts were accorded in principle approval by the Steering Committee of MSE-CDP held on 23-8-2010.

- a) Jinkunta(V) .... Mahabubnagar District
- b) Ghanpur(Stn)(V) ... Warangal District
- c) Mallemadugu(V) ... Khammam District
- d) Armour(V) ... Nizamabad District
- e) Mandamarri(V) ... Adilabad District

- g) Rukmapur(V) ... Karimnagar District.

4) MSME-DI Hyderabad has sensitized & provided guidance and support to KVIB Hyderabad for undertaking cluster Development activities under MSE-CDP. The KVIB has submitted proposals to MSME-DI for undertaking intervention in 28 clusters in AP. The proposals were scrutinized and some clusters were visited by our officers and the following 5 clusters are selected as having scope for undertaking interventions under MSE-CDP.

- a) Stone Cutting and Polishing Cluster, Bethamcherla
- b) Stone Cutting and Polishing Cluster, Tadipatri
- c) Cashew Processing cluster, Vetapalem
- d) Salt cluster, Naupada
- e) Power looms cluster, Warangal (ID Centre)

The proposals from KVIB for the above clusters as per the guidance provided by MSME- DI have been forwarded to Hqts. Office, New Delhi.

5) Director MSME DI attended the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> Steering Committee meeting held on 2-6-10 and 23-8-10 and gave presentations on the proposals submitted by us to DC MSME. In these two meetings, in principle approval was given to three common facility centers and 7 ID proposals submitted by MSME-DI, Hyderabad.

6) Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs (COWE) was provided guidance & support for submitting an application for in principle approval for ID project at Toopran , Medak Dist. Which was approved in the S.C Meeting held on 23-08-2010.

7) The Director and other officers of MSME DI, are having regular interactions with the cluster enterprises and their representatives . Thus focused discussions and meetings were held with the following clusters for motivating them and enabling them to come forward to take advantage of MSE CDP.

#### **IX. IMPLEMENTATION OF MSME SCHEMES:**

**a. ISO 9000/14000 reimbursement Scheme :** Under this scheme, MSEs with ISO 9000/14000 certification are eligible for reimbursement of 75% of expenses toward s acquiring ISO 9000/14000 certification, subject to a maximum of Rs. 75,000/- . During 2010-11, MSME-DI, Hyderabad reimbursed a total of Rs. 72.83 lakhs to 104 MSEs who have acquired ISO 9000/14000 certification.

#### **b. Capacity Building Scheme:**

Under the **Scheme for capacity building, strengthening of database and advocacy by Industry/Enterprise Associations and for holding Seminars/Symposiums/Workshops by the Associations,** MSME Industry Associations are eligible for a grant

- a. for acquiring office equipments like computers, fax, photocopiers etc, the maximum amount of grant being Rs. 5 lakhs, with a matching contribution from the Industry Association. . The amount of grant can be availed once in 4 years.
- b. for conducting Seminars/ Workshops/ Symposia at National/State/District level. Amount of grant is Rs. 2 lakhs/ 1 lakh/ 0.75 lakhs respectively.

During the year 2010-11, MSME-DI, Hyderabad recommended the proposals of the following Associations under this scheme:

1. For grant for organizing National level Seminars:

a. **Bulk Drug Manufacturers Association** – for organizing National Level Seminar on Pharma Industry

b. **Federation of AP Small Industries Association ( FAPSIA)** – for organizing Southern region MSME EXPO 2011.

2. Three proposals from Visakhapatnam Autonagar Small Scale Industrialists Association (VASSI), Uppal Industries Association, and Fibre Glass Industries Association of AP (FIAAP) were forwarded for grants for acquiring office equipment for building up data base. FIAAP has since been granted in-principle approval.

**c. Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme for Technology Upgradation :** MSME-DI, Hyderabad given guidance and forwarded a total of 21 proposals received from prospective entrepreneurs to concerned nodal banks for subsidy under the CLCSS scheme.

## **X. Production Index :**

**Production Returns:** MSME-DI, Hyderabad, with the help of Br. MSME-DI constantly send data on production of selected small scale units, to the Headquarters, for compilation of the production index. During the year, as per the target set, the Institute collected and sent 192 units production returns of 16 selected units manufacturing 18 important reserved items.

**Wholesale Price Index:** During the year 2010-1, MSME- DI, Hyderabad collected and dispatched data pertaining to 43 units, every month .

## **Fourth All India Census of MSEs**

Officers from EI/PI Divisions of the Institute and Br. MSME DI Visakhapatnam attended the ‘Training of Trainers’ programme in connection with sample survey of Unregistered units for 4<sup>th</sup> All India Census of MSMEs, at Chennai, from 26<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> March 2009. The officers trained enumerators for sample survey of unregistered units in all the districts in the State.

## **XI. CO-ORDINATION WITH OTHER AGENCIES:**

1. Director, MSME-DI, Hyderabad has been made the Convener of the State Level Co-ordination Committee on clusters for co-ordination of work under clusters in the state of AP, under the MSE-CDP scheme of the GoI .
2. Director, MSME-DI, Hyderabad is a member of various Committees in the State, set up by different Organizations, for implementing various policies of the Government of India, and Govt of AP. The important among them are the **State Level Inter Institutional Committee for revival of sick units, (SLIIC), State Level Bankers Committee Meeting (SLBC), State Level Selection Committee for National Awards, Task Force Committees in districts for PMEGP candidates selection, , Selection Committees of NSIC, etc.**
3. **State Level Advisory Board attached to MSME-DI, Hyderabad:** In accordance with the directions of the Development Commissioner (MSME), New Delhi, the State Level Advisory Board attached to MSME-DI, Hyderabad was reconstituted. Principal Secretary, (MSME), Govt of AP is the Chairman and Commissioner of Industries, Govt of AP is the vice- Chairman of the Board. The reconstituted Board has representatives of Govt Departments ( State and Central), Bankers, RBI, SIDBI, Industry Associations, SC/ST, Women & BC Finance Corporations, Academic experts, and professionals as its members. **The first meeting** of the Board was held on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2010 under the Chairmanship of Shri J C Sharma, IAS, Principal Secretary, Govt of AP. **The second meeting** of the Board was held on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2011.
4. During the year, MSME-DI, Hyderabad has worked in close association with many MSME Development organizations in organizing programmes for the development of MSEs. Important among these are **NIMSME, MSME Tool Room, SIDBI, NABARD, APSFC, APPC, Commissionerate of Industries & District Industries Centres, KVIC, Coir Board, ITDA, DRDA, etc.**
5. **Co-ordination with NSIC:** During 2010-11, MSME-DI, Hyderabad and NSIC conducted joint assessment of capacity in respect of **173 MSMEs**. MSME-DI, Hyderabad thereby earned a revenue of Rs. 4.7 lakhs

6. **Talks/Presentation:** Officers of MSME-DI, Hyderabad and Br. ## **XII. EXPORT PROMOTION:**

**Participation in International Trade Fairs:** MSME-DI, Hyderabad facilitated the participation of 14 MSMEs from AP in **International Trade Fairs** organized at different parts of the world, under the MSE-MDA assistance scheme. The list of the beneficiary units and the fairs in which they participated is given in detail in Annexure IV.

### **Training Programmes on Packaging for Exports:**

1. MSME-DI, Hyderabad organized a Training Programme on Packaging for Exports, in association with Indian Institute of Packaging and DIC East Godavari district, at Kakinada on , 30<sup>th</sup> October 2010. A total of 38 persons, including 5 women, 2 SC and SC-7 participated .
2. A Special Training programme on Export and Marketing of Jute products was organized by MSME-DI, in association with National Jute Board, at Visakhapatnam, from 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> October 2010. A total of 31 persons including 20 women and 3 SC participated.
3. MSME-DI organized a three days Training programme on **Packaging for Exports** was organized at Hyderabad, from 1-3 December 2010. A total of 26 persons, including 5 SC participated.

- **International Co-operation Scheme:**

1. MSME-DI Hyderabad recommended participation of a delegation of 40 entrepreneur members of the **AP Plastic Manufacturers Association, Hyderabad** to the **K2 International Exhibition of Plastics and Rubber, held at Düsseldorf, Germany, in October**



2. A delegation of 20 members of the **FRP** cluster was recommended to visit the **JEC Composite Show, Paris, during 20 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011**, to acquaint itself with the latest technology, and important developments in the field of FRP. The delegation visited the Fair and had an opportunity to interact with suppliers of machinery with latest technology, and with raw material suppliers. They also explored the market opportunities. ### **XIII. NATIONAL AWARDS**

MSME-DI invited applications from eligible MSME units for Government of India's National Awards for Outstanding MSME entrepreneur, for Best Quality Products, and for R&D efforts in the MSME sector. Scrutiny and recommendation of applications for the award was done to finalize nominations for the National Awards from the state of AP. The Institute organized a State Level Selection Committee Meeting of National Awards on 14<sup>th</sup> May 2010, at Secretariat, Hyderabad. The Committee forwarded 22 applications to the National Selection Committee. Entrepreneurs from Andhra Pradesh received a record number ( 14 ) of awards in various categories. The list of Awardees is enclosed as **Annexure V**.

### **XIV. MEDIA COVERAGE:**

The developmental activities undertaken by MSME-DI, Hyderabad received good media attention. Prominent local dailies covered the Institute's activities in detail, highlighting the salient work done by it in Entrepreneurship development in the state.

Apart from the above, many other press releases, advertisements, and news coverage on MSME-DI's and Br.MSME-DI's activities appeared in Newspapers and industry journals during the year under report.

**Beneficiaries of MSME-DI, Hyderabad's Training :  
Stories of Successful Entrepreneurs**

## 1. “” VISIT TO MADRID HAS BEEN VERY EDUCATIVE “

*M. Naveena was content to stay at home and tend to household work. But, with the children growing up, and household expenses rising, she decided to supplement the family income. She had ample time, and decided to put it to good use. She was not master of any particular skill, and hence could not start right away. To start a small enterprise, she needed to acquire a new set of skills. She was always interested in sewing and making creative things out of different kinds of materials.*

*She approached MSME-DI, Hyderabad, for an answer. She learnt that the Institute imparted various kinds of trainings, especially for women entrepreneurs. She boldly decided to get trained in the art of making jute bags. Once she was trained, there was no looking back. She pooled her resources, borrowed from family and friends and invested Rs. 1,00,000 to start Om Shakti Enterprises, at Secunderabad. MSME-DI was with her throughout the process*

*She tried her hand at new and innovative designs by gauging the pulse of the market. . She filed for EM Part II, with GM, DIC, Hyderabad, and has since then been supplying a variety of bags, folders, files etc made of jute and synthetic leather. Not content with supplying to the local market only, she tried to expand her market base by participating in various Exhibitions and Expo organized by MSME-DI, and other agencies in AP.*

*She took a progressive step further to explore international market. A great opportunity presented itself in the form of International Trade Fair at Madrid, Spain, in August 2010. She visited the Fair with the help of Govt of India subsidy under MDA Scheme. The visit helped her study the international market, preferences and prices of similar goods, the demand for Indian handmade bags, and proper positioning of her goods at the international level. It pleased her immensely to find that the bright colors and embellished environment-friendly bags were a rage in the European countries. She is in touch with the dealers and interested parties back in Europe and hopes to bag large orders some day.*

## *2. A successful woman entrepreneur – Ms. K A M Kameswari*

*“I always wanted to be an entrepreneur. I only didn’t know how to become one” says Ms. Kameswari, of Kukatpally, Hyderabad. Confident and collected as always, she diligently studied the market for opportunities that were both sustainable and lucrative. During the course of her exploration, she learnt about the different kinds of programmes and services offered by MSME-DI, Hyderabad, and met many officers of the Institute for various kinds of inputs. She felt that the training programme on Basic Electronics and Computer Hardware would help her set up her own enterprise in the areas of IT and enabled services. During the training, she discovered the many dimensions that running a small enterprise encompassed. She interacted with many experts, consultants, and bankers during the training programme, and her resolve to become an entrepreneur only became stronger.*

*After further research, she found that there was immense scope and demand for industrial safety products like safety shoes, gloves, goggles etc. She met more people from the industrial safety industry, and finally decided to start an MSME to manufacture these goods. She filed an EM on the name of M/s Sree Anjaneya Enterprises, at Kukatpally and started the unit with an initial investment of Rs. 16 lakhs( Rs. 10 lakhs Term Loan and Rs. 6 lakhs working capital). Independent and confident Ms. Kameswari now supplies safety products to many units inside and outside Hyderabad.*

### *3. Star caterer – Ms. B. Vijayalakshmi*

*Ms. B. Vijayalakshmi, a housewife based in Miyapur, Hyderabad was always interested in the art of cooking and knew that she was blessed with excellent culinary skills. She wanted to harness these skills and turn professional.*

*The Entrepreneurship and skill Development Programme organized by MSME-DI, Hyderabad in January 2010 was a blessing to her, as it introduced to her the world of entrepreneurship. She interacted with MSME-DI officers, faculty members, bankers, and others. She acquired hands-on experience in making Pizzas, Burgers, Bakery products, Noodles, Jams etc . Within three months of conclusion of the training programme, her blueprint for starting a bakery/food joint was ready. With hand-holding support from MSME-DI, she was successful in getting a loan of Rs. 1.5 lakhs ( term loan and lakh and 0.5 lakhs W/c). The food joint makes Pizzas, and other bakery products and is marketed in up-country Bakeries and Food Courts. She makes delicious treats and sweet-meats out of cashew and supplies them to five star hotels like Taj Krishna, and Taj Banjara . She aspires to increase her market presence and introduce the goodies with good packaging and create her own brand name.*

#### 4. "I am my own Master now"

### *The success story of Murali Sigireddy of Daba Gardens, Visakhapatnam,*

\*\*\*\*\*

*Shri Murali Sigireddy always had a burning desire to start an enterprise and be his own master. He felt it was a challenge to work his way up the ladder of success the hard way, by starting from scratch, rather than belong to the salaried class and follow the instructions of his employer. Equipped with a strong feeling to be independent, Shri Murali Sigireddy started scouting for opportunities that his limited resources would permit.*

*With this idea in mind, he was on the look out for some viable proposition, when he spotted the call for candidates to register for a training programme on "Cell phones repairing and servicing ", by the Branch office of MSME-DI, at Visakhapatnam. A small market survey helped Shri Sigireddy roughly estimate the demand for such services. With the number of cell phones being sold every month, and the increase in network to semi-urban and rural areas, he understood that the demand for repairing and servicing of cell phones would grow exponentially.*

*Shri Sigireddy enrolled for the training ( held from 5<sup>th</sup> October 2009 to 13<sup>th</sup> November 2009) at Visakhapatnam. Apart from technical skills, the Training programme included modules on Management development practices, procedures involved in running a small enterprise, managing finances etc. After completing the training, Shri Murali Sigireddy opened a service enterprise in the name and style of "Cell Lounge" at Daba Gardens, Visakhapatnam, on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2010. He invested Rs. 2 lakhs initially. He is running his service enterprise successfully, and is a proud employment provider to two others. He wishes to expand his business by availing Institutional credit. Officers of Branch MSME-DI, Visakhapatnam are ready to assist him whenever he needs their help.*

5. *“Training in Entrepreneurial Skills have been of immense use”*

### *Success story of Shri Ch. Durga Prasad*

*Ch. Durga Prasad had been employed in the bus body building industry and had gained good experience in the trade. Being adept at the job, he always dreamt of having his own workshop, but was at a loss about the procedure to proceed and realize his dream.*

*It was at this stage that he enrolled into the Entrepreneurship Development training programme of the Branch office of MSME-DI, and Viskhapatnam. He met the officers of the Institute and discussed with them about his requirements. He then realized that this programme would answer many questions that had been plaguing him. He underwent the training programme and emerged a confident man, ready to plunge into entrepreneurship. With a capital of Rs.3.5 lakhs, he set up his workshop in the name and style of M/s Prasad Body Building Works, at 48-8-21/2, Rajendra Nagar, Rajahmundry.*

*Though still grappling with initial teething problems, Shri Prasad is able to earn a profit of around Rs. 12,000/- per month. He is a satisfied man, as he is able to provide employment and livelihood to a few more persons.*

*b. "Ready to take-off"*

*Shri Suhas Balreddy of Bobbili, Vizianagaram district, an enthusiastic person raring to own an enterprise enrolled in the Entrepreneurship and Skill Development Programme on Chemical products, of the Branch MSME-DI, held in 2010-11. After acquiring training, he prepared a project report for starting an MSME with an investment of Rs. 100 lakhs to manufacture Detergent cake and powder . Officers of the Institute have helped him file Entrepreneurship Memorandum Part I. They also helped in applying for financial assistance under Credit Guarantee Scheme, through the State Bank of India. Shri Balireddy succeeding in getting sanction for the loan, and is now in the process of acquiring various approvals from different agencies.*



## 7. BRINGING CREATIVITY TO THE FORE
